About the project

The tender for the project is expected to be released soon and therefore we are looking to identify experts now in preparation for the shortlist.

The EU-funded Technical Cooperation Facility of the Support Measures constitutes part of a financial envelope in the Multiannual Indicative Programme for Sub-Saharan Africa (SSA MIP) which allows DG INTPA unit A.02 for Regional and Multi-Country Programmes for Africa, as well as other DG INTPA Units, EU Delegations (EUDs) and potentially other key stakeholders in Sub-Saharan Africa to make use of technical assistance. Technical assistance is needed to translate through appropriate programme identification, formulation, and implementation of the political and strategic priorities formulated in the SSA MIP into concrete activities achieving the intended impact. Technical support is also needed for monitoring of actions and to implement evaluation services to assess the results achieved through the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument – Global Europe (NDICI-GE) support, as well as stakeholder consultations, negotiations, policy dialogue and development related to the EU cooperation under the SSA MIP and its priorities.

About the roles

We are seeking to recruit numerous positions with experience in EU development cooperation, working in the African continent and with specific areas of technical expertise. Expert positions and requirements will be confirmed at tender stage, upon release of the Terms of Reference.

The provisional contract commencement date is 1 September 2025 with a contract duration of 48 months, with variable inputs across expert roles.
